This lovely home past stewards were the Rumpp family. The Rumpp family owned and manufactured fancy leather goods on 47<sup>th</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> Street in Philadelphia PA. They manufactured the leather goods from the 1800's to 1959. They reportedly made cartridge belts and leather cases for the Union army during the Civil War. It was also reported that two U.S. presidents had Rumpp leather desk sets in their White House offices. The original factory was at 108 North Front Street, Philadelphia and a later factory at 5<sup>th</sup> and Cherry streets. At one time they had showrooms in New York city, Chicago, And Los Angeles. They used this home as a summer home to get away from the hectic city life. The property was at one time over 200 acres and includes a chauffer's house, wash house, garage, barn, and other buildings to sustain this stately home.
